3. **Three written references - two from high school teachers and one from a person in the community.**

Additional Requirements

1. The applicant's family must be a member of the Pleasant Run Farms Civic Association, and reside in Pleasant Run Farms.
2. Applications must be typed or prepared on a computer. The application and authorization form are available on the PRFCA website at www.pleasantrunfarms.org.
3. **Deadline for applying is March 31, 2012.**
