The following items must be included in your application.

1. Completed application, including parent or guardian signature (if applicant is less than 18 years of age as of March 31, 2019).
2. Completed academic information, including parent or guardian signature, if needed. An acceptable alternative is to submit an official high school transcript—fee paid by applicant.
3. Two written recommendations: one from a high school teacher or counselor; and one from a person in the PRF community.

Additional requirements:

- a. The applicant's family must be current residents of Pleasant Run Farms and members of the PRF Civic Association as of March 31, 2019.
- b. Application must be typed or prepared on a computer. The application and authorization form are available on the PRFCE website at [www.pleasantrunfarms.org](http://www.pleasantrunfarms.org).
- c. Applications must be completed and returned to Wendy Puccini (12033 Deerhorn Drive) or Bert Cameron (11987 Deerhorn Drive) no later than March 31, 2019.
