



PRFCA BOARD MEETING MINUTES

A General Meeting of the Pleasant Run Farms Civic Association was held November 19, 2015 at 7:00pm at John Wesley UMC. Following are the minutes from the meeting.

The meeting was called to order at 7:10pm by President Kevin Puccini. Minutes from last month's meeting were accepted by the board.

President: Kevin Puccini –

Kevin had nothing to report, but stated he wanted to discuss old business towards the end of the meeting.

Vice President: Anna Fields –

Anna reported that Springfield Township has changed the fee structure for renting The Grove. She also mentioned that Deerhorn is on the list for resurfacing, but doesn't know a timeframe yet. On December 14, there is to be a township trustees' meeting regarding the Warden Nursery project (land donated to township that was directed to be a park for at least ten years; now has developer interest).

Treasurer: Ed Mayer –

Ed provided financial reports. He reported the beginning balance on Oct 22 was \$9538.29 and the ending balance on Nov 19 was \$9838.89. Income this month was from memberships and there were no expenses in this reporting period. A motion was made to accept Treasurer's report, motion seconded; Treasurer's report accepted.

Secretary: Connie Fears –

Connie mentioned that she plans to review and revise the scholarship application before the next meeting but will also send proposed revisions to the board members right away, since the board isn't planning to meet in December. She also reported that Christina Norris has agreed to serve as chair of the 2016 scholarship committee, since Connie is recusing herself from running the process this year (daughter is a high school senior who will be applying for the scholarship).

Athletic Director: John Buschman, interim director -

John reported soccer season has ended. Boys' and Girls' Wings as well as Boys' Strykers participated in tournaments. Work is progressing on closing up the fields and the township has been notified to proceed with winterizing the building at the field. The township has been working on the electrical issue with the sign. Finally, preparations will be underway soon for spring baseball registration.

Communications: Venita Vivians –

Venita reported that she needs items for the December Memo by Nov 27. Distribution is expected to be on the first weekend of December.

Membership Report: Linda Boylson, interim chairperson

Linda reported that several 2016 memberships have been received thus far. (Persons interested in picking up the Membership chair position can contact any member of the PRFCA board.)

Community Activities: Linda Boylson

Linda Boylson stated she plans to publicize community activities on NextDoor as well as in the Memo. Discussion was held regarding reaching not just members but the entire community as well, with consensus that multiple ways (including facebook and PRF's website) should be attempted. Linda has a lot of ideas for bringing back more community activities that have been done in the past and possibly adding a few new things to the mix.

Pool: Erin Knox –

Erin was unable to attend the meeting.

Old Business:

Marsh fundraiser: John stated that, with focus at the time on the luminaria project, he hasn't had time to obtain more information on the Marsh fundraiser. He will look into it in the near future and report back to the board.

Luminaries: Flyer distribution was done throughout the neighborhood, with many orders having come in quickly. Last day to order is Saturday Dec 5; with pickup on Dec 12 at the pool from 10am to 12pm. The order form requested an email

Old Business (continued):

address, so reminders will be emailed to those who ordered. The board will work together to assemble the kits on Dec 9, so that pickup on the 12th can basically be a drive-through process. Residents are asked to light their luminaria on Dec 20 from dusk until the candles burn out; and a backup date, in case of inclement weather, will be on Dec 22.

Membership and Memo: The board has come to agreement that the membership issue (falling membership revenues, at least in part due to membership fees no longer being collected by the pool and sports) can be alleviated by cost savings from changes to hard copy Memo delivery schedule. Further discussion was held regarding how many hard copy Memos should be produced in 2016; with a plan to have only 2 copies distributed this year (March and September). Changes can be made in the future if this plan doesn't seem to be optimal.

New Business:

Board: Suggestion was made to bring a senior citizen from the Farms onto the board as an advisory position, to be a presence on the board for this segment of the community and to be a liaison back to the seniors of PRF. Further discussion on this point will be done in future board meetings.

Being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 8:42pm.

Next meeting is a general meeting, to be held on Thursday, January 28, 2016 at 7:30pm in the cafeteria at Welch Elementary.
