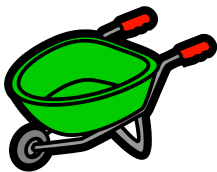

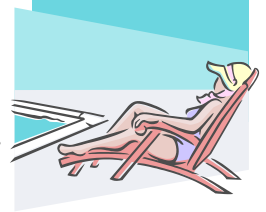

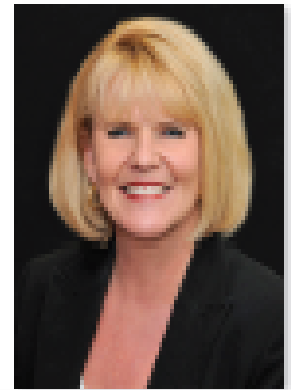

## SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS RECYCLE

Springfield Township Residents Recycled 1,060.57 Tons in 2012

Congratulations Springfield Township residents! In 2012, we recycled 1,060.57 tons of metal, glass, plastic and paper. That is equal to the weight of 212 Asian elephants. Residents saved resources, conserved energy, and reduced pollution by recycling.



The recycling efforts in Springfield Township:

- Conserved enough energy to power every home in Springfield Township for 5 days.
- Reduced more greenhouse gas pollution than if every household in Springfield Township rode their bicycle to work for almost three weeks.
- Saved 8,125 trees from being harvested.

Recycling reduces pollution so the air we breath is cleaner, conserves natural resources so we will have them to use in the future, and decreases the energy needed to make new products. Recycling also boosts our local economy by creating 169,000 jobs (4.3% of all jobs) just in the State of Ohio.

On average, each household in Springfield Township recycled 153 pounds in 2012. That's 9.05% of all the waste we generate. If you would like to see even more material recycled in 2013, check out the list below to make sure you include all these materials in your recycling bin. Don't have a bin? Call 946-7766 to learn more about requesting a bin or cart.

Good work, Springfield Township, our recycling efforts made a big difference!

- Plastic bottles and jugs (lids are OK if left on empty bottle)
- Aluminum and steel cans
- Empty aerosol cans (remove and dispose of lids and tips)
- Glass bottles and jars (remove and recycle lids)
- Paperboard (cereal boxes, etc.)
- Junk mail and envelopes
- Magazines, catalogs, and phone books
- Newspapers
- Cardboard
- Office Paper
- Brown grocery bags
- Clean pizza boxes

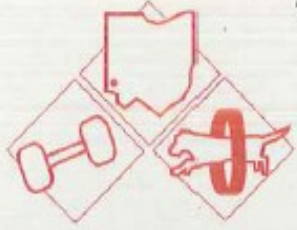
