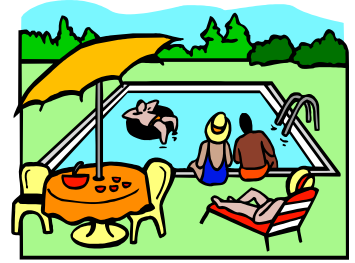
## POOL NEWS FROM PRF SWIM CLUB

March 27, 2014

A meeting of the Pleasant Run Farms Civic Association was held Thursday, March 27, 2014 at 7:00pm at the home of Erin Knox, pool director. The following are the minutes from the meeting:

The meeting was called to order at 7:13pm.

Chris Gilbert, Assistant Township Administrator/Development Services Director, opened the meeting to discuss Issue 13, which will be on the May 6<sup>th</sup> ballot. If approved, the measure would allow for the development of a Joint Economic Development Zone/District (JEDZ) to replace funds lost when the Ohio State Legislature eliminated certain taxes. Information about the JEDZ can be found in this memo or on the Township's website. Also, Chris plans on attending next month's General Meeting at Welch Elementary to speak to the public regarding the proposal and answer questions. Please plan to attend the General Meeting next month if interested.

President: Kevin Puccini – No new report at this time.

Vice President: POSITION REMAINS OPEN. If interested in this position or questions, please contact Kevin Puccini.

Treasurer: Ed McNett reported membership continues to go up at this point in 2014, and we are keeping pace with last year as far as budget goes. Therefore, we will be able to keep the same services as last year, including all hard-copy memos and community activities.

Secretary: Christina Norris reported next month's meeting will be a General Meeting, held at Welch Elementary library on Thursday, April 24<sup>th</sup> at 7:30pm. The PRFCA scholarship will be presented to the winner at that time.

Athletic Director: John Buschmann sat in tonight to give report, as Athletic Director's position is currently open. Spring sports is fielding 14 teams this year (t-ball, baseball and softball). Fields are currently being raked and otherwise set up. Opening day at Clifford George Field will be held on Saturday, April 5<sup>th</sup>. See article in this memo regarding opening day events.

Communications: Venita Vivians – not present but submitted written report beforehand. Advised April's memo will be a hard copy memo, to be distributed the weekend of April 5<sup>th</sup>. All ads and articles are needed by 03/29. Reviewed articles needed for April's memo.

Membership discount cards for 2014 members can be picked up Saturday, March 29 at the concessions stand at Clifford George Field. 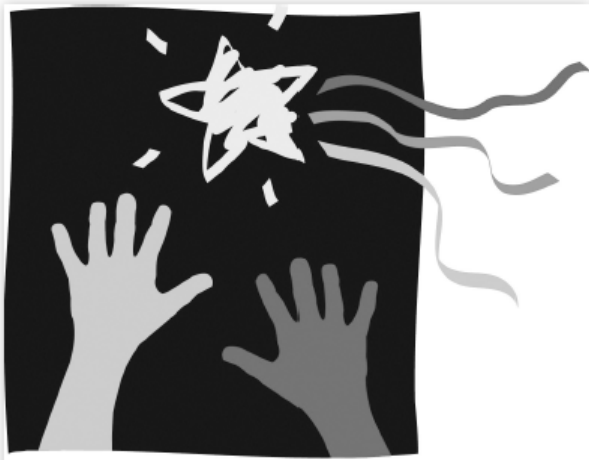
## 2014 St. John Neumann Festival Raffle Official Rules

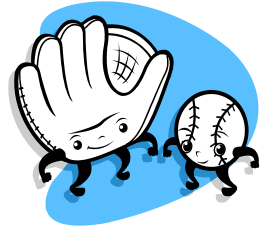

# JOINT ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ZONE (JEDZ) - MAY 6TH ELECTION



What is Springfield Township's proposed Joint Economic Development Zone (JEDZ)? Utilizing existing state law, the Township is proposing to partner with the City of Mt. Healthy to create a joint economic development zone (JEDZ). The designated zone includes properties in Springfield Township where businesses are located and/or individuals work, excluding home-based businesses.

The JEDZ will enable the collection of a 1.5% payroll/earnings tax on businesses and individuals who work in the zone. As required by law, the City of Mt. Healthy must collect the tax and allocate the revenue between the Township and the City based on the percentage outlined in the agreement.

The City of Mt. Healthy provided the Township with the most advantageous partnership agreement and gives Springfield Township the best option for future long-term collaborations aimed at reducing costs and dependency on property taxes.

### Birthday Trivia

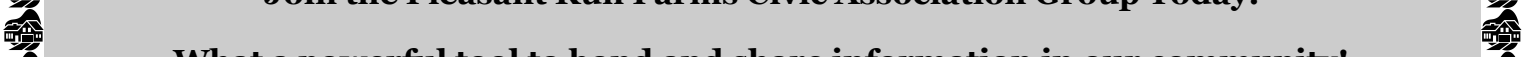
- The day of the week in which the most babies are born is Tuesday while Sunday has the fewest births.
