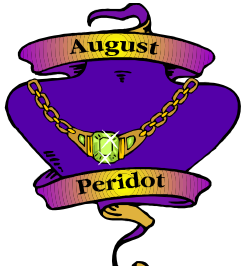

Old Business: None

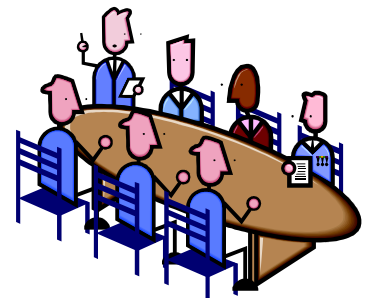
New Business: Voting held to accept new board members for positions of Vice President and Community Activities Director, as stated above.

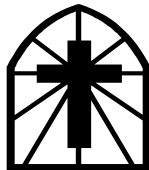

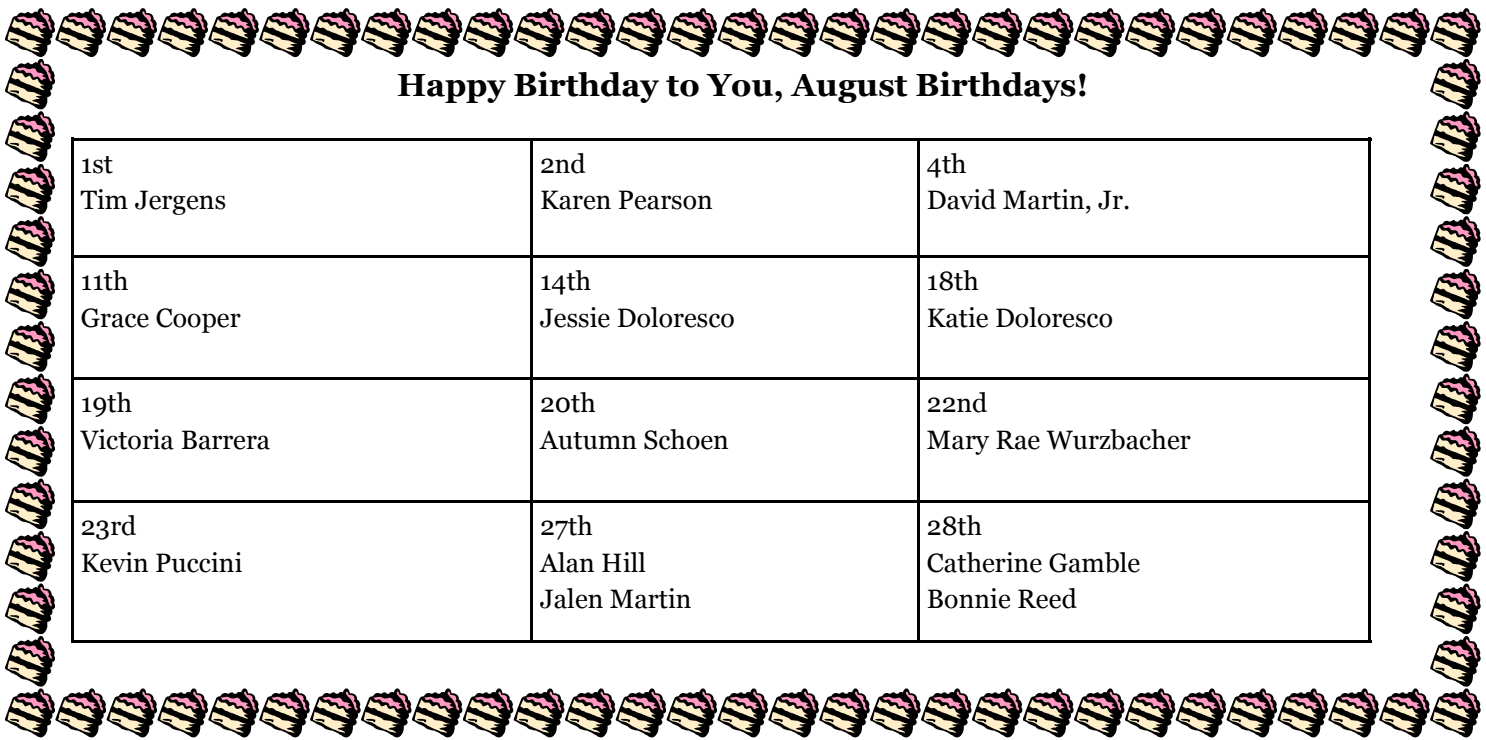
